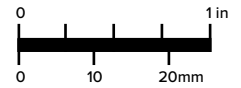


How to Determine Your Ring Size



Printing Instructions

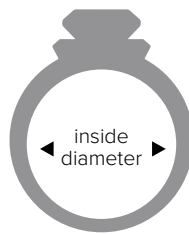
1. To obtain accurate measurements, please download this PDF to your computer and print this document at a page size of 100 percent.
2. Verify the page scale setting prior to printing by checking your printer dialog box. Under the page scaling option, select "none" or uncheck the box for page scaling.
3. Compare a ruler or U.S. Quarter with the guides on the right to ensure your printed document is the correct size. The marks of the ruler should match precisely and the U.S. Quarter should completely fill the circle shape.



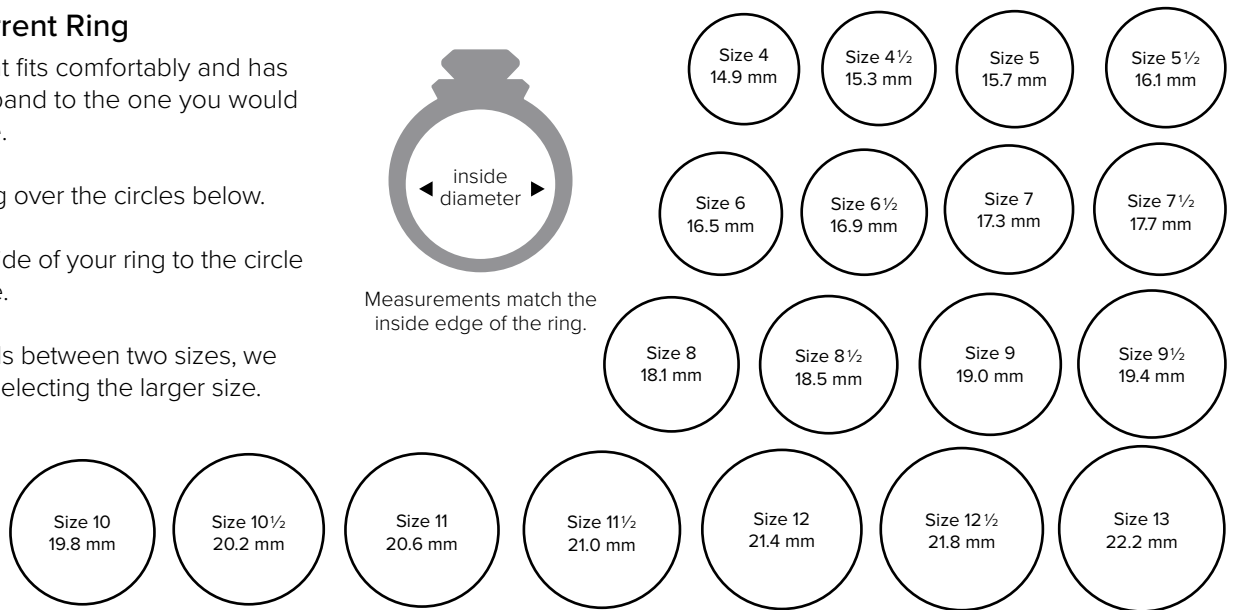
Measure Current Ring

Use the ring that fits comfortably and has a similar width band to the one you would like to purchase.

1. Place your ring over the circles below.
2. Match the inside of your ring to the circle closest in size.
3. If your ring falls between two sizes, we recommend selecting the larger size.



Measurements match the inside edge of the ring.



Consider Band Width

All of our rings are available in full and half sizes. Generally, a band ¼" or wider will require a half size larger. Tapered rings will fit your normal ring size.

fits your normal ring size



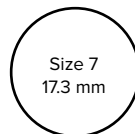
Tapered Ring
